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## 6Attendance

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8All Board Members and attendees were present via the District's conference call 9account in accordance with the CDC and CDPHE recommendations regarding COVID – 1019.

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12The following Directors were present: Al Pfister, John Porco, Candice Kelly, and Bill 13Hudson.

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15Also present were: Jeff Kane, Renee Lewis, and Chris Mannara.

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## 17**Call to Order**

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19The Special Meeting for the San Juan Water Conservancy District (SJWCD) was called 20to order by Chairman Al Pfister at 6:38 p.m.

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## 22**Revisions to Agenda**

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24Director Porco requested his anticipated reappointment and any necessary direction for 25the attorney be added to the agenda. The Board agreed. Chairman Pfister requested 26the announcement of the Watershed Enhancement Partnership Zoom meeting on May 2728, 2020 at 6:30 p.m. be added to the agenda. The Board agreed.

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# 29Declaration of Conflicts of Interest

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31The Board considered Declarations of Conflicts of Interest. No conflicts were declared. 32

## 33**Public Comment**

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35Chairman Pfister opened the meeting to public comment. No comments were offered. 36

37<u>Consideration of Attorney Report – Executive Session – Settlement with PAWSD</u> 38<u>and Boot Jack, LLC on the Following Water Rights Cases: 17CW3030;</u>

3917CW3041; 17CW3043; 17CW3050, and 18CW3051 in Executive Session Pursuant 40to Sections 24-6-402(4)(b) and 24-6-402(4)(e), C.R.S.

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42The Board considered Attorney Report – Executive Session – Settlement with PAWSD 43and Boot Jack, LLC on the Following Water Rights Cases: 17CW3030; 17CW3041; 4417CW3043; 17CW3050, and 18CW3051 in Executive Session Pursuant to Sections 24-456-402(4)(b) and 24-6-402(4)(e), C.R.S. Jeff Kane presented Consideration of Attorney 46Report– Executive Session – Settlement with PAWSD and Boot Jack, LLC on the

47Following Water Rights Cases: 17CW3030; 17CW3041; 17CW3043; 17CW3050, and 4818CW3051 in Executive Session Pursuant to Sections 24-6-402(4)(b) and 24-6-402(4) 49(e), C.R.S. stating, he anticipates a resolution soon as the SJWCD and PAWSD 50concerns have been addressed with the latest proposed decree from Boot Jack, LLC. 51The Board directed Mr. Kane to proceed with settlement negotiations as authorized 52during the February 3, 2020 Executive Session. The Board did not enter into Executive 53Session during this meeting. The Board also directed Chairman Pfister to contact the 54President of the Park Ditch Company regarding the progress of the settlement 55negotiations.

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#### 57Discussion Regarding Letter to Town of Pagosa Springs Regarding SJWCD 58Impact Fees

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60The Board agreed to move this item ahead on the agenda so as to make the best use of 61Jeff Kane's time. The Board considered Discussion Regarding Letter to Town of 62Pagosa Springs Regarding SJWCD Impact Fees. Chairman Pfister presented 63Discussion Regarding Letter to Town of Pagosa Springs Regarding SJWCD Impact 64Fees, stating he briefly discussed this matter with the Pagosa Springs Town Manager 65as directed by the Board at the April 20, 2020 meeting. The two agreed the matter was 66best handled by their respective attorneys. Mr. Kane indicated that he had not yet 67heard from the Town's attorney. A motion was made by Director Hudson and seconded 68by Chairman Pfister to have Mr. Kane contact the Town's attorney if he had not heard 69from him by June 1, 2020. The motion passed unanimously.

## 71Consideration of Reappointment of Director Porco

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73The Board considered Reappointment of Director Porco. Chairman Pfister presented 74Consideration of Reappointment of Director Porco, stating that Director Porco had 75submitted his letter for reappointment to District Court. The Board inquired of Jeff Kane 76the next steps for reappointment. Mr. Kane indicated he would need direction to file the 77necessary follow-up paper with the Court. A motion was made by Director Kelly and 78seconded by Director Pfister to file the necessary paperwork for Director Porco's 79reappointment. The motion passed unanimously.

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#### 81 Discussion Regarding Preliminary Determination of Reservoir Size 82

83The Board agreed to move this item ahead on the agenda so as to make the best use of 84Jeff Kane's time. The Board considered Discussion Regarding Preliminary 85Determination of Reservoir Size. Director Hudson presented Discussion Regarding 86Preliminary Determination of Reservoir Size, stating he believed a subcommittee of the 87Board should be established to determine the reservoir size. Following a lengthy 88discussion, the majority of the Board agreed more research is needed by professionals 89prior to the Board establishing a subcommittee or considering reservoir size.

## 91Consideration of Treasurer's Report

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93The Board considered Treasurer's Report (copy attached). Director Kelly presented the 94Treasurer's Report, stating the highlights of the deposits, expenses, and ending 95balances. Director Kelly also requested authority to move \$25,000 from the District's 96operating checking account to the ColoTrust account. A motion was made by Director 97Hudson and seconded by Chairman Pfister to authorize Director Kelly to move \$25,000 98from the operating checking account to the ColoTrust account. The motion passed 99unanimously.

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### 101Consideration of SJWCD Website Hosting

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103The Board considered SJWCD Website Hosting (copy attached). Director Hudson 104presented Consideration of SJWCD Website Hosting, stating the current hosting 105company charges \$39.00 for an SSL Certificate and he would be able to host the 106SJWCD website through his company at no charge. A motion was made by Chairman 107Pfister and seconded by Director Kelly to engage \_\_\_\_\_\_ for SJWCD website 108hosting. The motion passed 3 – 0 with Director Hudson abstaining.

#### 110Consideration of Request for Information

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112The Board considered Request for Information. Chairman Pfister presented 113Consideration of Request for Information, stating there has been an indication of local 114interest in the Request for Information regarding the San Juan River Headwaters 115Project. Chairman Pfister also stated he had received an estimate for a proposed 116project map of \$1000 – 2000.00. A majority of the Board agreed to not expend funds on 117a map at this time and to request delaying the Request for Information from PAWSD. 118The Board also requested Chairman Pfister inquire of the interested party if it would 119want to provide a proposal without a formal Request for Information.

121There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned 122at 8:04 p.m.
